Learn About Denver Health's Lean Journey

In 2005, Denver Health began applying Lean principals to their performance improvement efforts. The program has been successful and continues today. We'll learn more about the journey during our May Member Event on May 9th.

The presentation will feature Denver Health's Assistant Director of Lean Systems Improvement, Jeremy Lee. He will share some of the insights gained through the improvement process. And we will learn how Denver Health strives today to utilize Lean methodologies to achieve their performance goals.

Jeremy Lee started with Denver Health as Lean Facilitator in August 2014. He

was promoted to Assistant Director in June of 2016. Previously, he was in higher education administration at Regis University, managing service learning programs in several schools. He led multiple intercultural and global service programs and taught a graduate level course on global health. Prior to this, Jeremy served two years in Peace Corps Ecuador as a health education volunteer. Jeremy's focus on social justice for the underserved has made Denver Health a perfect fit.
